Who can apply?

- Undergraduate student enrolled at least in the 5th semester when applying
- Master student
- PhD student
- Young graduates who graduated after January 1st, 2019
- Not older than 29 years
- Internships are offered in the field of economics, business administration, engineering, computer science, commercial law, journalism, agriculture, biology and chemistry
- Candidate with a very good command of English and/or German*
- * No specific language certificates are needed. If you want to do an internship in the field of architecture or commercial law, B2 level of German language is a precondition.
